Construction has begun on the world's longest roller coaster at sea aboard the new ship, Dream Cruise's new ship Global Dream.

Partial assembly of the main attraction "Dream Park at the Pier", the first theme park at sea, completed in dry dock.

HONG KONG, MUNICH (December 09, 2021) – In October 2019, Dream Cruises and Maurer Rides announced the world's longest roller coaster at sea on board the new Global Class cruise ship, Global Dream. The "Spike®-Coaster" type roller coaster - called Space Cruiser by Dream Cruises - will be the highlight of the "Dream Park at the Pier", the very first theme park at sea.

In order to keep the assembly and commissioning time for the 2500-cabin cruise ship as short as possible, the roller coaster is currently being built for testing in the immediate vicinity of the MV WERFTEN shipyards in Germany.

At the beginning of the year (2021,) the survey of all base coordinates for the trial assembly of the roller coaster took place at the site. Immediately after sending the coordinates, MV Werften began with the preparations and the production of the deck foundations. The first foundations were measured on board the Global Dream in late summer 2021 so that a section of the roller coaster could be assembled in MV Werften's dry dock. This allowed the successful October planned dock assembly of the station section at MV Werften in Wismar, Germany.

With the dock assembly of the first section, another important project milestone was reached for what will soon be the longest roller coaster at sea. At the same time, the partial assembly served as a dress rehearsal for all project participants for the final assembly of the remaining roller coaster sections planned for spring 2022.

The first photos of the construction process show the scope and scale of the dock assembly for the world's longest offshore roller coaster.
